FISCAL COURT MEETING
September 13, 2022 Special Meeting

An adjourned special meeting of the Calloway County Fiscal Court was held at 3:30 pm on Tuesday September 13, 2022 in the Calloway County Court House Annex. Judge Executive Kenneth C. Imes called the meeting to order. The following duly-qualified members of the Court were present: Squire Eddie Clyde Hale, Squire Don Cherry, Squire Paul Rister, and Squire Larry Crutcher. Also present were: County Treasurer Tonya Robinson, Deputy Judge Gina Winchester, County Attorney Bryan Ernstberger, and County Clerk Antonia Faulkner.

Mrs. Tonya Robinson, Co. Treasurer, presented to the Court for approval of a bill from MPI for road paving. After a discussion, motion made by Squire Rister seconded by Squire Hale to pay the bill. All voted aye and it was so ordered.


Mr. Jamie Hughes, director of the Health Department, presented to the Court the department's tax rate. The rates; 3.1 cents per \$100 (motor vehicle tax) and 2.8 cents per \$100 (real and personal property taxes) have not changed in several years, something they have worked well with and are proud of.

In the form of a motion, Judge Imes presented to the Court personnel changes. Cynthia Chrisman and Kennita Roy as receptionist at the Annex, Kevin Lee as a seasonal laborer at the Road Department. Part-time employee Justin Tidwell, Solid Waste Coordinator, will be added the duties of Floodplain Coordinator. Lisa Farris and Michael Westfall will be leaving.

Motion seconded by Squire Cherry to approve the order as presented. All voted aye and it was so ordered.

The Court then discussed the reappointment of Bob Rogers and Kenneth C. Imes to the Industrial Development Authority Board of Directors to expire 7/31/2026. Motion made by Squire Rister seconded by Squire Crutcher to approve the reappointment as presented. All voted aye and it was so ordered.

There being no further business before the Court motion made by Squire Hale seconded by Squire Rister to adjourn. All voted aye and it was so ordered.
