The training for the job consists of a Ph.D. in European history, an amaterax interest in military history, atudy and travel in Europe before the war, a year of writing training history on Second Army, a year of combat interviewing with First Army in the European Theater, two years in editorial and writing phases of the Miskorialx distorical Division, ETOUSA; Historical Division, USFET; and Historical Division, War Department; travel during or since the war in Englandx France, Belgoum, Holland, Luxembourg, Ikalyxxivatriaxx Germany, England, Italy, Austria, Switzerland, Czechoslovakia and Egypt, with extensive travel over the battlefields of the first five countries; and considerable experience in interviewing.
