



- l. Transmitted herewith is a Report of Reinterment together with Medical Examination Report and Dental Chart for human remains removed from an isolated grave on a former battlefield near Myitkyina, Burma. It is noted from Medical Examination Report that these remains comprise a complete skeleton on which was found an Identification Tag and an Identification Bracelet bearing the name PARVIN COOK, 35725779. These remains were reinterred in Plot 3, Row W, Grave 31, at the U.S. Military Cemetery, Barrackpore, India.
- 2. It is advised that this headquarters already has a PARVIN COOK, 35725779, PFC. 475th Infantry, interred in Plot 8, Row S, Grave 1892, in the U.S. Military Cemetery, Kalaikunda, India. A Form 1042 accomplished by a previous headquarters, concerning this burial, shows that subject decedent was removed from Plot 8, Row B, Grave 88, U.S. Military Cemetery at Myitkyina, Burma. GR Form #1, shows that no Identification Tags were found on the remains but that one was attached to the Wooden Cross marking the grave.
- 3. Because of this duplication this headquarters reexamined the grave in Kalaikunda Cemetery and found that it contained a complete skeleton, on which a Dental Chart was accomplished and is attached herewith as Inclosure No.2. It is requested that the Dental Chart referred to above and the Dental Chart accompanying attached Form 1042 be compared with the War Department Records of "PARVIN COOK" to ascertain which compares favorably with his remains, and results of findings furnished American Graves Registration Service Honolulu.
- 4. In either case one of these burials will be that of an unidentified individual, therefore, it is further requested that the Dental Chart for the unidentified remains be compared with the charts of other personnel carried as "MISSING" or "KILLED" in the Myitkyina, Burma area in an effort to establish identification.



- 1. When the remains are delivered for interment in a civilian or private cemetery, you are responsible for paying all interment expenses. In this connection, you are entitled to the allowance mentioned in paragraph 2 below.
- 2. An amount not to exceed \$75 is allowed by the Government toward actual interment expenses when final interment of the remains is in a private or civilian cemetery. No allowance is authorized toward interment expenses when interment is in a national or post cemetery.
- 3. The \$75 maximum allowance by the Government toward interment expenses includes but is not limited to the payment of one or more of the following items: Hearse hire from the railroad station to your home, the funeral home, church, cemetery, or any other place designated by you; vault; church services; newspaper notices; transportation for friends and relatives to and from cemetery; and the services of a funeral director.
- 4. Reimbursement by the Government is made only to the person who paid from his personal funds the expenses of or incident to interment in a private or civilian cemetery. Receipted bills are not required to accompany this form. Any expenses over and above the \$75 maximum must be borne by the person who incurred or paid the additional expenses.

EXPLANATION OF BOX "B"

1. When the remains are delivered to you at Government expense prior to burial in a national or post cemetery, you are responsible for all additional expenses necessary to deliver the remains from that point to the national or post cemetery grave site. However, you may be entitled to an allowance for the cost of transporting the remains from your home to the national or post cemetery grave site subject to the conditions outlined in paragraph 2 below.
