Farm Classes

When the war was over, classes were provided to the returning veterans as one form of compensation. They were a way to reorient the farm boys and teach them about new practices, somewhat like the GI Bill. The Murray Training School advertised a class to start in January 1946. Other classes were formed in Pottertown, New Concord, Lynn Grove, and elsewhere across the county.
