

AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED ORDINANCE
CREATING THE
CALLOWAY COUNTY OFFICE OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

WHEREAS, the Calloway County Fiscal Court approved after a first reading on November 12, 1998, a proposed Ordinance Creating the Calloway County Office of Emergency Management;

WHEREAS, the proposed ordinance contained a clause calling for a criminal penalty and it is believed that the Kentucky Revised Statutes provides adequate penalties;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CALLOWAY COUNTY FISCAL COURT:

SECTION I: Section V of the above mentioned proposed Ordinance is deleted. The deleted portion of the ordinance provides as follows:

Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, or any lawful orders, rules or regulations promulgated pursuant to it, upon conviction shall be guilty of a Class A misdemeanor. Violators of this ordinance may be issued a citation by the Sheriff of Calloway County or by a duly authorized official.

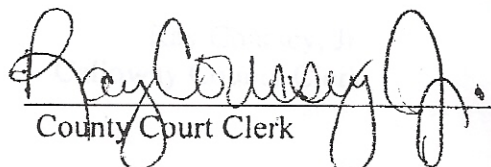
SECTION II: In all other respects, the above mentioned proposed Ordinance is adopted in full.

The second reading of an Ordinance creating the Calloway County Office of Emergency Management will be held Tuesday, February 16th, 1999 during the regular meeting of the Calloway County Fiscal Court which will be in the District Courtroom of the Calloway County Judicial Building at 312 North 4th Street.

Summary of Ordinance is as follows.

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE CALLOWAY COUNTY OFFICE OF
EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF CALLOWAY COUNTY

The fiscal court of Calloway County desires to protect and safeguard the property, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens and the environment of Calloway County in accordance with the provisions of KRS Chapters 39A to 39F;

The office of Emergency Management is created in accordance to the provisions of KRS Chapter 39B.010 relating to implementation of program, unit of county government, jurisdiction, responsibility, and budget.

The Calloway County Fiscal Court will appoint the Calloway County Emergency Management Director.

The Calloway County Emergency Management Director shall have and exercise all the powers, authorities, rights, and duties as specified in, or referenced in, KRS Chapter 39B.030, and in the orders or ordinances of the fiscal court of Calloway County.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval, adoption and publication, and all ordinances or parts or ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed and held for naught.

Approved on first reading on the 12th day of November, 1998.
