FISCAL COURT MEETING
July 20, 2026, Special Meeting

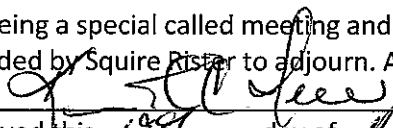
An adjourned special called meeting of the Calloway County Fiscal Court was held at 9:00 AM CST on Monday, July 20, 2026, in the Calloway County Court House Annex. Judge Executive Kenneth C. Imes called the meeting to order, led the pledge of allegiance, and a prayer. The following duly qualified members of the Court were present: Squire Don Cherry, Squire Paul Rister, Squire Larry Crutcher and Squire Ricky Stewart. Also, present were County Treasurer Tonya Robinson, Deputy Judge Executive Gina Winchester, County Attorney Bryan Ernstberger and Assistant Co Atty. David Perlow, and County Clerk Antonia Faulkner.

By way of a motion, Judge Imes called for Executive Session. Motion was seconded by Squire Rister and all voted aye. Ms. Janette DeWitt of Kopperud Realty was invited into the session.

By way of motion, Squire Rister moved to exit the Executive session, and it was seconded by Squire Crutcher. The Special meeting was called back to order by Judge Imes. Motion made by Squire Rister to list the remaining two lots at Western Shores by way of a ninety (90) day service contract with Kopperud Realty, with no offer to be accepted until after 21 days to give the public the opportunity to view. Motion seconded by Judge Imes. All voted aye and it was so ordered.

The Court then reviewed personnel action. Motion made by Judge Imes seconded by Squire Cherry to approve the action as presented. Discussion followed, based on the discussion Squire Cherry withdrew his second. The motion to approve failed due to no second. No action was taken.

This being a special called meeting and no other items on the agenda, motion made by Squire Crutcher seconded by Squire Rister to adjourn. All voted aye and it was so ordered.
