

CALLOWAY COUNTY
FISCAL COURT MEETING
July 30, 2026, Special Meeting

An adjourned special called meeting of the Calloway County Fiscal Court was held at 8:00 AM CST on Thursday, July 30, 2026, in the Calloway County Court House Annex. Judge Executive Kenneth C. Imes called the meeting to order and led a prayer. The following duly qualified members of the Court were present: Squire Don Cherry, Squire Paul Rister, Squire Larry Crutcher and Squire Ricky Stewart. Also, present were County Treasurer Tonya Robinson, Deputy Judge Executive Gina Winchester, Environmental Coordinator, Justin Tidwell.

Judge Imes presented the certified ad valorem tax rates and revenue estimates received from Robert Brown, State Local Finance Officer with Department of Local Government pursuant to KRS 68.245-249. By way of motion, Judge Imes moved to accept the 4% proposed tax rate of 13.90 on real property. Motion seconded by Squire Rister. All voted aye and it was so ordered.

A motion to adjourn was made by Squire Rister and seconded by Squire Crutcher. All voted aye and it was so ordered.

At the request of Judge Imes, a motion to withdraw the adjournment was made by Squire Crutcher seconded by Squire Stewart. All voted aye and it was so ordered.

Judge Imes called the special meeting back to order and reminded the court that tax rates on all other property must be set at this time. Squire Rister then made a motion to keep the personal property and motor vehicle tax rates the same as last year at 16.08 and 14.00 respectively. Judge Imes seconded the motion. All voted aye and it was so ordered.

This being a special called meeting and no other items on the agenda, motion made by Squire Crutcher seconded by Squire Rister to adjourn. All voted aye and it was so ordered.
